## Two more rescued!



We got a call about two sisters living in very tragic circumstances. At only 10 and 7 years old they have faced much in their lifetime. Their mother had shot them up with drugs daily to keep them quiet, and the girls had been sexually abused. They came with nothing more than the clothes on their backs, heads full of lice, and tummies full of bacteria infections and parasites. We spent the first week buying them clothes, taking them to the doctor, and of course having some fun. It's so important for children to learn how to be children again. When God brings children to us, we never know how long they will be in our lives. All we know is that they have come to us for a purpose even if it's just for a season. After we got the girls back on their feet, we were able to reconnect them with their aunt! They are now in a safe, loving, and christian home. We are so happy for them. In Thailand, our school schedules are quite different. In October, the children get to have a 3 week break from school! We always enjoy this time with the kids. Their teachers let us know that the children are excelling in English and that they are all so smart!

On our way deep into the mountain it began pouring down rain and was extremely foggy. We were praying for the rain to stop so we could continue our trip as planned but it didn't. After an hour-long drive, we didn't know how we could possibly pitch tents in the weather. We were able to talk with the people at the campground and they said they had one group room for rent. We were so happy that God made a way for us to stay that night. It continued to rain all night through to the next day. We had planned to camp for 2 days but weren't able to stay because everything was closed due to rain. Instead we opened camp mahawon at our own home! We pitched tents in the yard, barbecued, played games, and had an amazing time. These are the moments we'll never forget!
